1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.3 The sailing instructions may change RRS.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.6 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at www.manage2sail.com and the notice board is in the Watersport vereniging Hellecat. The online notice board is leading the communication. Tele- and datacommunication is not allowed during the race except emergency.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to open beach catamarans based on the latest **texel rating** handicap (www.watersportverbond.nl).



- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and submitting it, together with the required fee, as shown at www.manage2sail.com by October **10th 10:00 hrs**. Only online registration will be accepted.
- 4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees. This can only be done online (by bank transfer).

5 ENTRY FEES

- 5.1 Entry fees and data for registration are as follows:

- 5.3 One free entry will be raffled among all participants. The winner must be personally present at the prize-giving ceremony to claim the prize.
- 5.4 Afterwards; Hellecat members will receive a €25 refund on their entry fee.
- 5.5 Sailors' dinner on Saturday is **included** in the entry fee.
Additional diner vouchers can be bought for €15 at the bar on Saturday, depending on availability.

6 RTG and Oktober Cup

- 6.1 The Sunday of the RTG event is also part of the Oktober Cup.
- 6.2 Participants who participate in both events do not pay extra for the first RTG Sunday; after that, you pay the registration fee for each Sunday. See NOR Oktober Cup.

9.2 The regatta office desk is in cantina of the clubhouse of "WSV Hellecat".

Saturday, October 10th the long-distance race "Ronde Tiengemeten" is scheduled.

9.3 Sunday, October 11th wind- lee-ward races are scheduled, to a max of 4
On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 15:30 hr.

9.4 Boats can be parked at the club a weekend before and after the event, free of charge.

10 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

10.1 Equipment inspection and event measurement:
There will be no pre-measurements. During the regatta, any boat and its equipment may be subject to examination at any time.

11 CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

While afloat each boat shall have on board:

- A righting line, at least 8 mm in diameter
- An extra line (for towing) of at least 10 meters and at least 8 mm in diameter
- While afloat all competitors must wear:
 - An approved functional floatation device or life jacket of at least CE50 Newton standard, or equivalent

- a wet- or dry suit
- an approved personal **emergency signal**, to be carried on the body.

While afloat all competitors sailing on a foiling catamaran must wear in addition:

- A helmet
- An impact (safety) jacket with a functional floatation device of at least CE50 Newton standard, or equivalent.

No car parking is allowed near the clubhouse, only in the Quackstrand parking area.

- 12.2 Transport of the boat from the parking lot to the beach is allowed under the condition that once the trailer is unhooked the car needs to go back immediately to the Quackstrand parking area.

- 12.3 Boats can only be brought to the venue on the listed dates in the schedule and the weekend before RTG. Outside these moments, boats must be parked at the large parking area and not in front of the clubhouse.

- 12.2 NOR Appendix A shows the plan for the event venue.

- 12.3 NOR Appendix B shows the location of the racing areas.

13 COURSES

- 13.1 The course diagram in appendix C and D shows the courses, the course designations, the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be port.

- 13.2 Ronde Tiengemetten RTG on Saturday:

- Start line: In front of Watersport vereniging Hellecat.
- Gate:
 - East of the harbor of Middelharnis there will be a gate.
 - Between Marks:
 - Yellow Q-flag on committee boat
 - Mark red HV 18
 - In case of shortening the course flag T  will be shown on the committee boat.



- Tiengemetten is to be rounded Counter-clockwise, Tiengemetten on port side.
- Rounding Tiengemetten, between:
 - Mark yellow close to VG15
 - Hellecat Flag on committee boat
- Finish line: is in front of Watersport vereniging Hellecat

13.3 Wind- Lee-ward regatta on Sunday

14 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 14.1 For all class(es) RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

15 SCORING

- 15.1 Ronde Tiengemetten is a single-day event.
- 15.2 Weekend Tiengemetten is long distance race combined with course races. The result of the long distance cannot be discarded.
When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score, with the exception of the long-distance race "Ronde Tiengemetten".

21 DATA PROTECTION

- 21.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio, and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

22 RISK STATEMENT

- 22.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.'

By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform, and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes....

23 INSURANCE

- 23.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 or the equivalent per incident.

24 PRIZES

- 24.1 For the long-distance Ronde Tiengemetten the prizes are as follows: Prizes will be given to the helmsmen and crew. The winner must be personally present at the prize-giving ceremony to claim the prize. For:
- Line Honours
 - Overall
 - Best Single-handed
 - Best Hellecat team (rotating trophy cup)
 - Best Youth team
- 24.2 Weekend Ronde Tiengemetten
Prizes will be given to the helmsmen and crew, of the first, second, and third-ranked boats in the final standings. The winner must be personally present at the prize-giving ceremony to claim the prize. For:

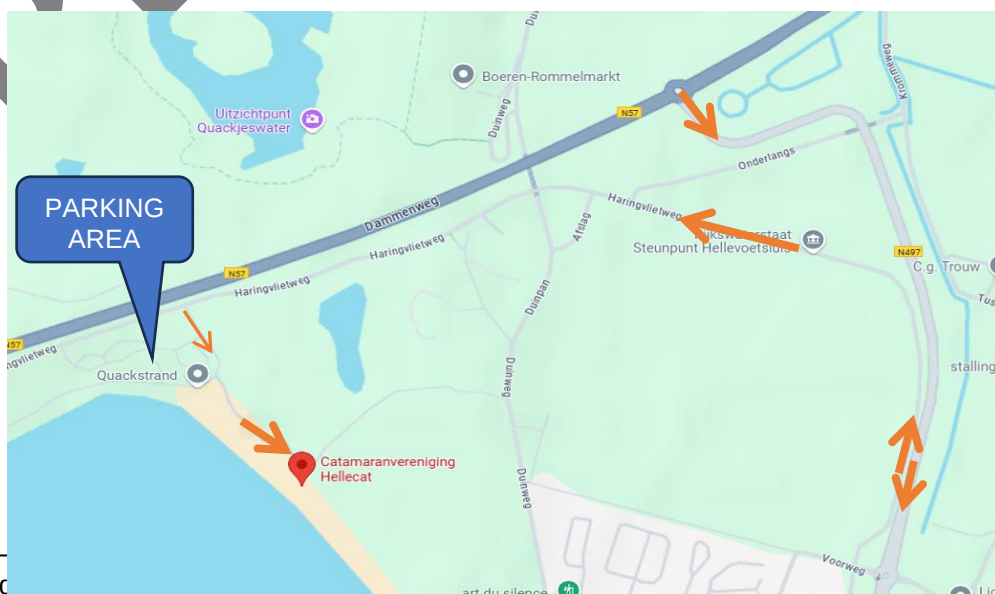

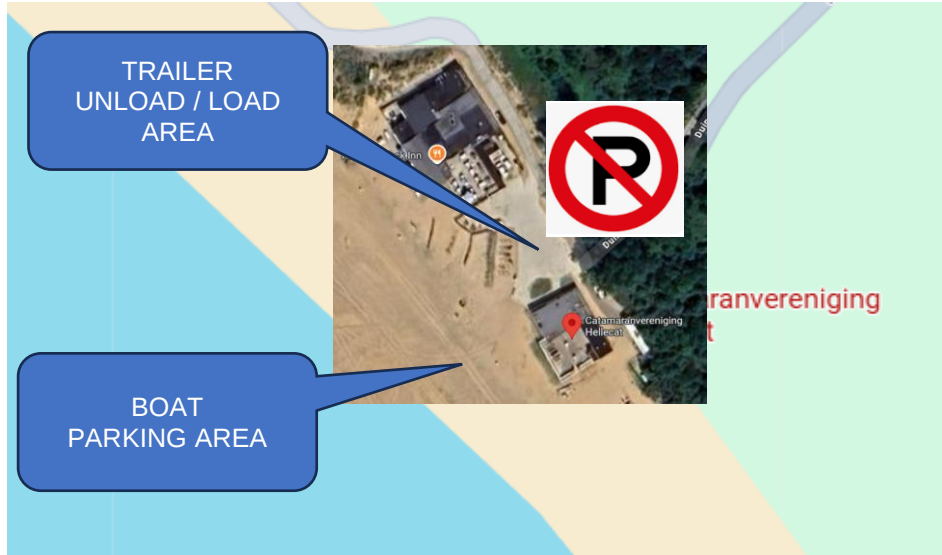
Appendix A: the map of the event venue

Appendix B: the location of the Wind- Lee-ward regatta racing area

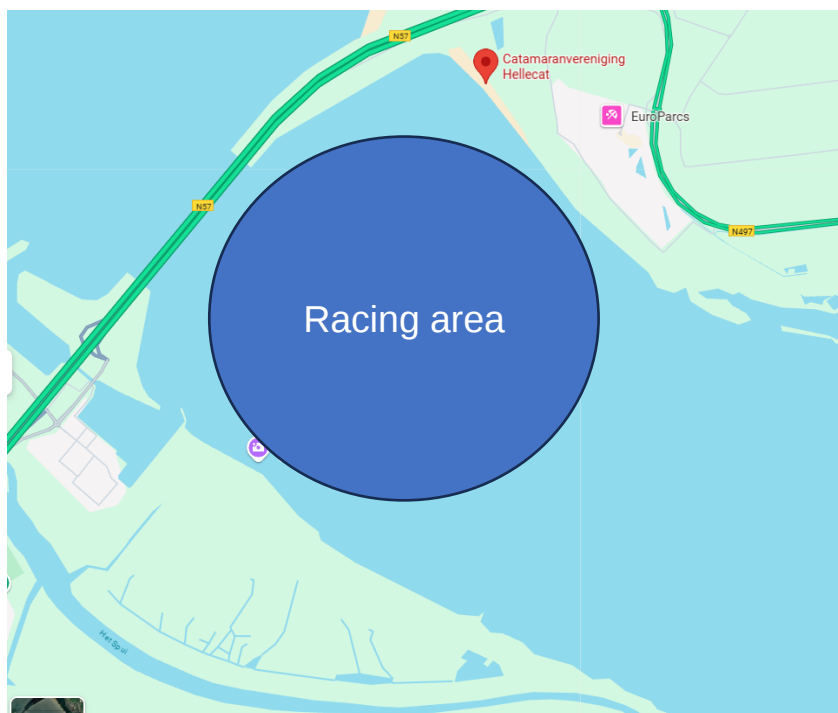
Appendix C: the map of Rond Tiengemetten

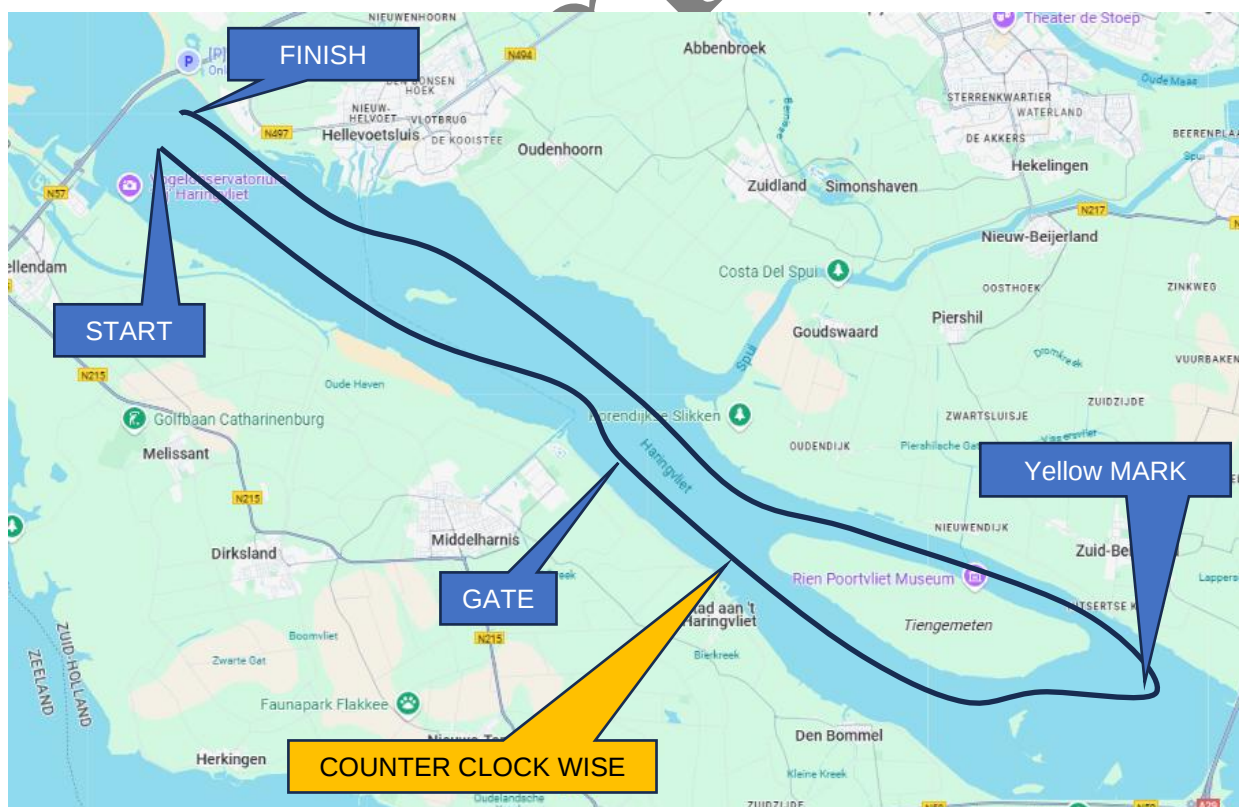




APPENDIX B: Start area
